3. Minutes

a) Andrew introduced the BlackCanonCollective committee representatives to the newer members involved in the meeting and each explained their roles. Queries were raised regards the insurance, membership fees. All were answered and in agreement.

b) Chris Smith was appointed the role of the jump spot representative. He will govern any digging/ building in the area to ensure that all work carried out is to a good standard and that unauthorised building will not take place. Neil is to be notified by Chris of all work being carried out to ensure that its conform to the BCC's role as land manager.

c) The jump spot will be for all standards and will have separate lines for the pros and a beginner line set up consisting of tables. There will also be different trails working up to the pro line for progression. This was agreed by all involved and any building in the future must take this into account.

d) In order for the site to develop Chris, Sam and Gary requested that they bring in 2 wooden kickers to get the distances between jumps perfect. This was agreed and they will be brought in immediately, providing that the Longleat estate were happy to allow such a structure in.

The first jump to go up will be a large tabletop to test the ground and also provide an immediate platform for any level rider to go jumping. This will start at the top of the jump spot site.
